It is important that I get my eyes checked so that I can see well.


We plan a visit to the eye doctor.

When it is my turn, the doctor's friend helps me with some special games before I see the doctor. These games are done on machines. These machines look different, but they don't hurt.




The doctor's friend explains what I should do. I can ask questions if I don't understand.



On the first machine, I have to look at a hot air balloon.


As part of the game, the doctor's friend makes the hot air balloon blurry and clear. That's okay! I just have to keep looking at it.
